Statically hosted site, used Jekyll as a templating engine. This improved my ability to go from mockup to CSS quickly, and working remotely with the channel owner and communication over FaceTime and messages improved my communication skills. Currently in the process of overhauling site- adding a dynamically generated blog, migrating from a statically hosted Jekyll site to a dynamically hosted Node / Express site, and adding an administration interface for easier updates for the business owner.

Worked on internal inventory management system for The Colour Bar, a Sacramento hair salon. Worked remotely, and used Vue.js for frontend and Node for backend.
